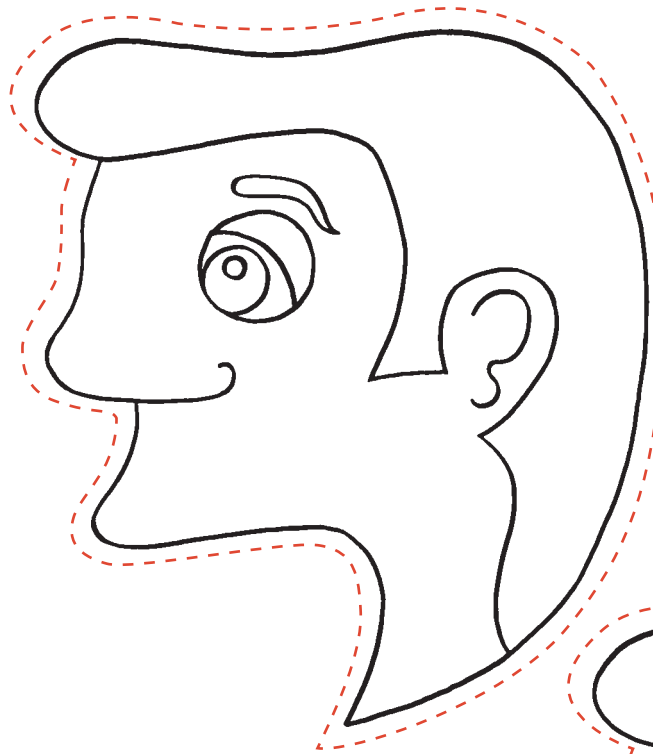
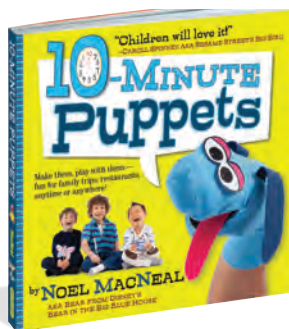
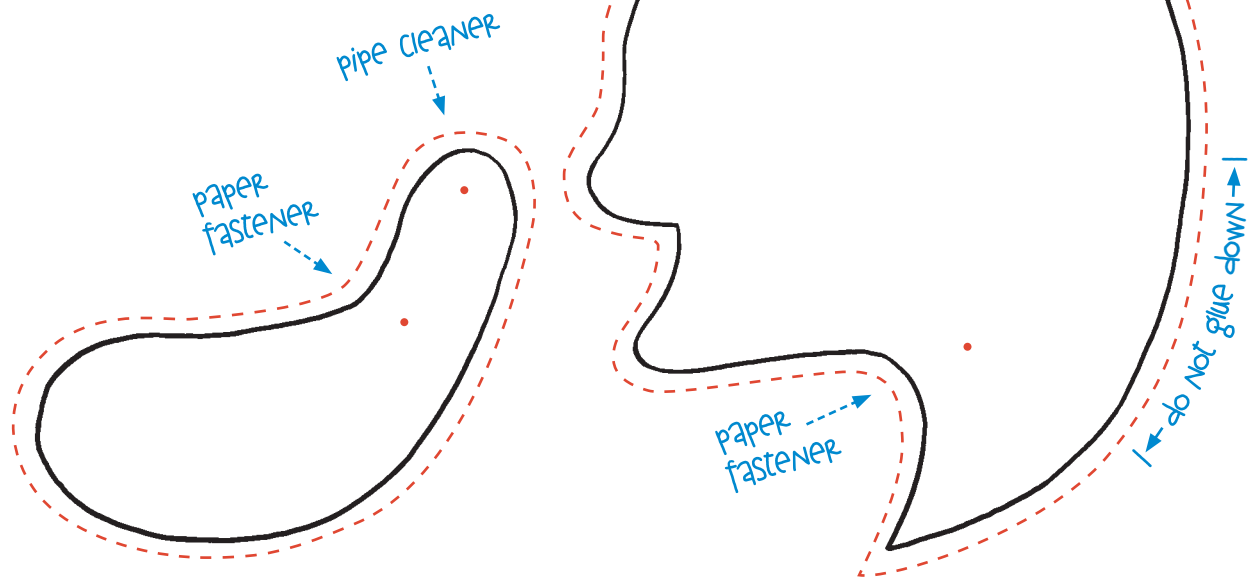


FACE THAT TALKS



Color in the face pieces and glue the sheet to lightweight cardboard. Carefully cut out the pieces and punch holes at the dots. Thread a pipe cleaner through the back hole in the jaw to make a flexible handle, then loosely attach the jaw to the back of the head with a paper fastener. Glue the front and back faces together along the profile, then tape a chopstick or pencil to the back piece as a handle. Pull the pipe cleaner to maneuver the puppet's mouth!
